Environmental Information Regulations 2004 Request Amelia Earhart Centre

Thank you for your recent request regarding the Amelia Earhart Centre. Please see information below:

- The Amelia Earhart Centre was first opened in 1989
- From 1991 the facility operated in partnership with legacy Council, Derry City Council and the Ballyarnett Racecourse Society who provided staff
- It closed temporarily for some refurbishment and reopened in December 2003
- Closed in 2009 (Ballyarnett Racecourse Society were intending to lease it directly; however this did not happen)
- Opportunities are being considered to address the legacy of Amelia Earhart's connection with the city as part of the ongoing local community planning process
