Environmental Information Regulations 2004 Request Missed Bin collections Amended

I refer to your EIR request and can advise that unfortunately figures are not available prior to 1/1/18.

Information we can provide however is that from the 1/1/18 until 31/12/18:

Missed Bins for this period due to adverse weather conditions - 71 roads/streets approximately 982 bins.

Missed Bins for this period due to access issues e.g.road works, parking issues approximately - 250 bins.

I can also advise that apart from the above, the majority of missed bins are due to non-presentation on the morning of collection. These are not recorded.

Council are responsible for 55000 alternative weekly black and blue collections, approximately 35000 weekly food waste collections and 9000 Green Waste (garden and food combined) collections fortnightly.

If you are dissatisfied with our response you have rights of review and appeal; these rights consist of two review processes.
