Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request - Community Protection Notices

I refer to your FOI request and respond as follows:

Request

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to request the following information held by your authority for the calendar years 2022, 2023, and 2024 (or the most recent available data):

- 1. The total number of Community Protection Notices (CPNs) issued by the council.
- 2. If available, please provide a breakdown by the type of behaviour or issue the notice was related to (e.g., noise, graffiti, fly tipping, waste, nuisance).

Response

As the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 does not extend to Northern Ireland the Council has not issued any such notices.

If you are dissatisfied with our response, you have rights of review and appeal; these rights consist of two review processes.
