Requests made to the legacy councils since 1 April 2015 are being handled by Derry City and Strabane District Council and duplicate requests made to the legacy councils are being treated as one request.

• Who provides the organisations BACS payments and Direct Debit collection software?

Danske Bank – Online Services (for BACS processing both Payroll & Ans: Accounts). Please note that separate organisations (Legend and Competition line) provide Direct debit collection for our leisure services.

How you came to the decision to choose these companies?

- Ans Danske Bank & Legend were chosen following competitive tender processes in line with public procurement guidelines. Competition line is a legacy Council arrangement which will be up for review in September 2018.
- Are these solution(s) hosted on premise or cloud hosted?

Danske bank is web banking, (Cloud) Ans: Legend is also cloud based and run from Legends servers Competition line – managed service. Unknown how processed after export.

Please provide expenditure on computer software used for Bacs payment processing and Direct Debit collection. For financial years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016.

Information only available from 01 April 2015 following reorganisation Ans: of local government in Northern Ireland as outlined.

- Payroll (BACS) Link to from Danske to Payroll Software = £2,425 per annum.
