### Publication of LDP Preferred Options Paper

In accordance with Regulation 10 of the Planning (Local Development Plan Regulations) (NI) 2015, Derry City and Strabane District Council hereby commences consultation on the Preferred Options Paper for the Local Development Plan 2032 (LDP).

The Council's Preferred Options Paper (POP) is published on 31st May 2017 as part of the Local Development Plan process. It is intended to promote debate on the main issues of strategic significance which are likely to influence the preparation of the Council's new Local Development Plan (LDP). The POP outlines the vision, objectives and key planning issues affecting this District, possible options on how to deliver new development and planned growth, what the Council's preferred options are and the rationale for those preferred options.
