## Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request Irish language & Ulster Scots language

I refer to your FOI request as outlined below:

## **Request:**

Please advise for each of the last three complete financial years how much your authority has spent, both internally and externally relating to;-

- 1) Irish language eg training, celebration, education, literature, events, translation, salaries for specialist officers
- 2) Irish culture, eq dancing, music, parades, bands and other arts, festivals etc.
- 3) Ulster Scots language eg training, celebration, education, literature, events, translation salaries for specialist officers
- 4) Ulster Ulster Scots culture, eg dancing, music, parades, bands and other arts, festivals etc

Please include all expenditure on council signage in council buildings, on vehicles, street signs, stationary etc

Please include all grants made to external organisations

Please give details of every item, including cost, nature of item and date.

## **Response:**

Please find attached spreadsheet outlining Financial Information that Council has available. It should be noted that it can be difficult in terms of cultural events to

explicitly define 'Irish Culture' and 'Ulster-Scots Culture' as they can be subjective definitions and there is a considerable amount of integration and overlap between both areas.

Further to your request for Council to provide details of all expenditure on council signage in council buildings, on vehicles, street signs, stationary etc, Council seeks clarification as to the exact nature of the information you require? Eq is your request in respect of the 4 questions of your query where language is used on said formats, or is the information you require in to all Council spend in these areas? Councils deadline has frozen in respect of this clarification request on this issue.
