

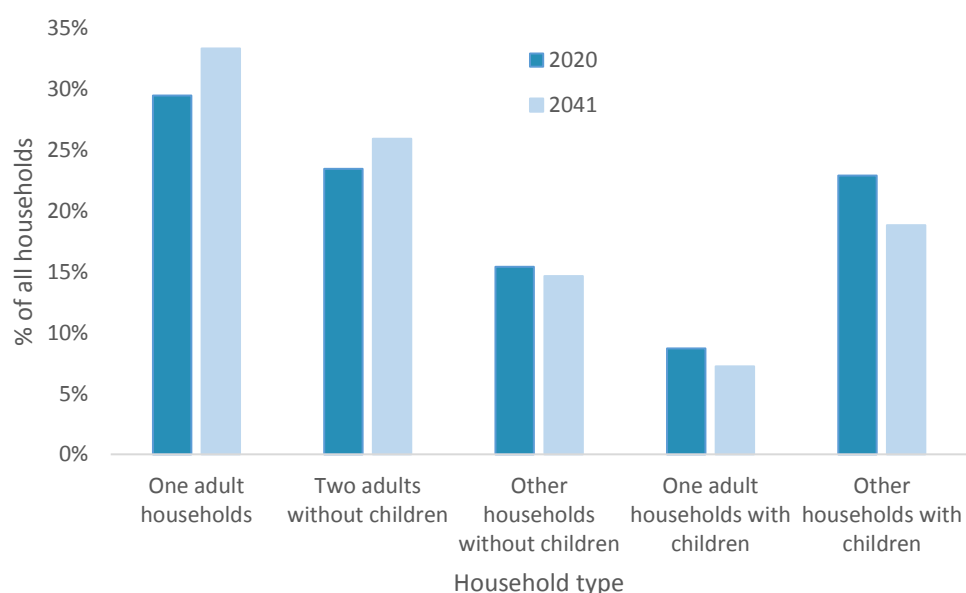

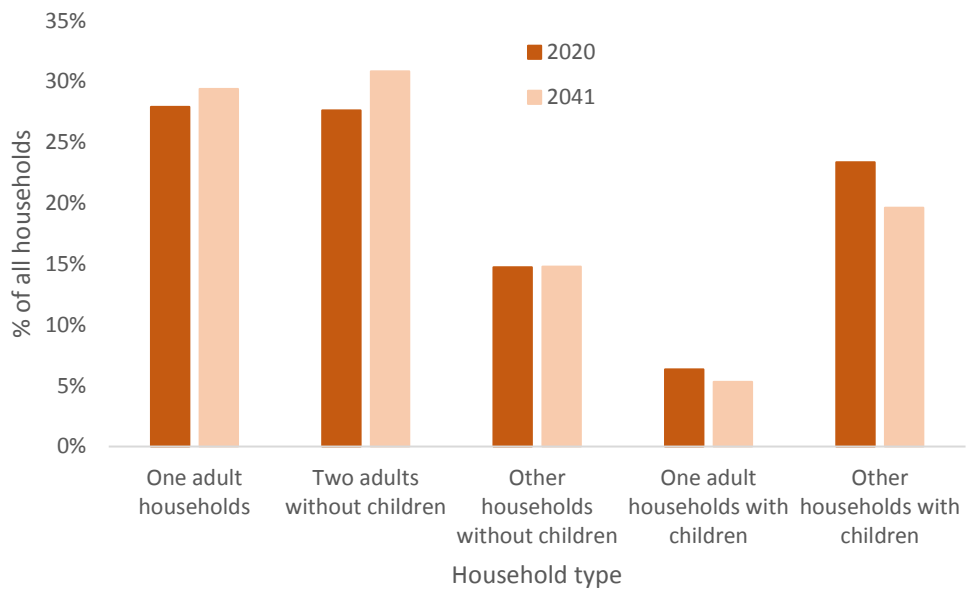

- In 2020, the latest household projections estimated that 'One adult' households made up the largest type of household within DCSDC (17,200 households or 29.5%). This rate was above NI as a whole (27.9%).
- Households with children are estimated at 18,400 of all households here, equating to 31.6% of all households (29.7% for NI).
- By 2041, the number of 'One adult' households are expected to increase by 2,900 bringing the projected total to 20,100 or 33.4% of all households. This would be a higher rate than that projected for NI (29.4%).
- Conversely, by 2041, the number of households with children is projected to fall by 2,700 to 15,600 households or 26.1% of all households (25% for NI).
