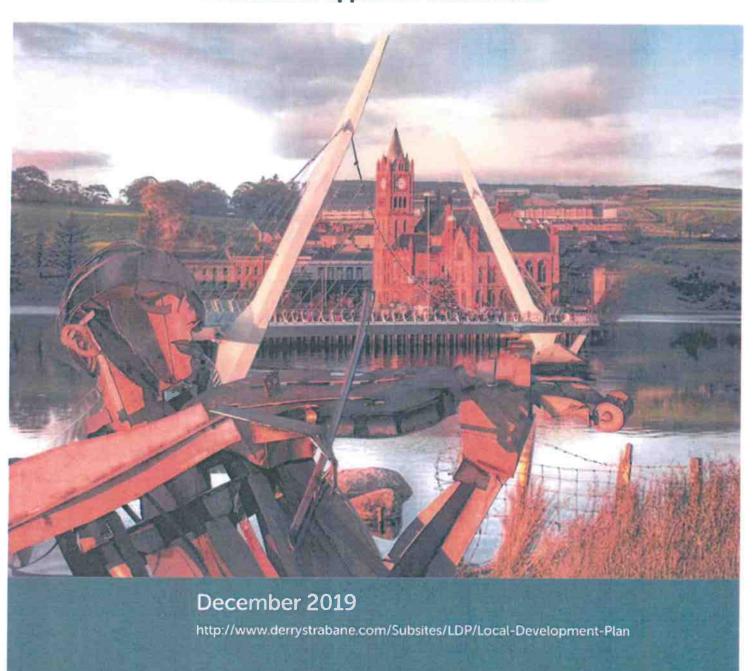

#### Introduction

Derry City and Strabane District Council is planning for the future. It is the start of a challenging and exciting journey. It will be a long-term and collaborative process, driven by the Council which is committed to grasping the opportunities and addressing the challenges that face us, some unique to our situation and others generated by global forces beyond our control.

United by a shared vision, the Council's Local Development Plan (LDP) and our Community Plan - the Strategic Growth Plan, will drive this process as we seek together to strategically grow and improve social, economic and environmental wellbeing for all. #### Table 8: Indicative Allocation of Housing in DC&SDC by Settlement Tier 2017-2032

Table 8 indicates an allocation of between 135 – 180 dwellings to the small settlements. This equates crudely to an allocation of circa 10 dwellings per settlement throughout the LDP period depending on their size, available land, function within the district and local facilities and infrastructure. We support the draft Plan Strategy's proposal to allocate dwellings to the small settlements in order to sustain their future throughout the LDP period. In relation to Goshaden, given that the settlement is largely built out there is scope at the LLP stage to provide additional dwellings within a revised SDL on a LUPA.

Table 2: Allocation of Housing over LDP Period 2017-2032 for DC&SDC Settlements, based on Settlement Evaluation and Plan Spatial Strategy indicates that Goshaden's indicative potential for more housing post April 2017 is low. Given its location and that the settlement is largely built out we would contend that the indicative potential for more housing post April 2017 should be at the very least medium, particularly as there limited development opportunities within the settlement to sustain it throughout the LDP period. Similar to Table 1 Goshaden is again the only settlement within the District which has '0' current housing capacity therefore there is a strong argument for additional allocation throughout the LDP period. We assume it is classed as low given its proximity to Derry and the A6 as per categories 78 and 81 in the footings at the bottom of Page 504 where growth in such settlements will be restricted. We do not agree with the Council's reasoning for this. We note that in the column titled Indicative Share of District's Housing 2017-2032 Goshaden is the only settlement in the District not to have a figure inserted. We assume that this is in error.

We request that the draft Plan Strategy and allocation figures to the small settlements facilitates appropriate growth to meet a range of accommodation needs throughout the LDP period.
