Environmental Information Regulations Request - Nelipak Healthcare Packaging Derry

I refer to your EIR request and respond as follows:

Request

We are undertaking an environmental audit for a site in Derry – Nelipak Healthcare Packaging, Campsite Industrial Estate. As part of the audit, we request information surrounding any environmental history on the site that the council may possess.

It is noted this site holds a PPC permit (PPC/07/C/0045) issued by Derry City Council on 02/04/2008.

We would like to request any information regarding environmental records, pollution incident records and environmental complaints in relation to Nelipak Healthcare Packaging, Campsite Industrial Estate, Acorn Rd, Campsie, Londonderry BT47 3GQ.

Response

Environmental Records

The site operates under a Permit Ref: PPC/07/C/0045 which was issued by the legacy Derry City Council. The operator is permitted to carry out the activity listed in Schedule 1, Chapter 6, Section 6.4, Part C (a) (iv) of the Pollution Prevention and Control (Industrial Emissions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2013.

The Local Authority PPC permitted installations and mobile plant within the Derry City and Strabane District Council area that have been issued a permit to operate are shown on a map on the Council website.

Environmental complaints

The Environmental Health Service of the Council holds a record of a noise complaint received on 25th May 2017 regarding plant on the site. More historically, in July 2007 following complaints from local residents about noise, an abatement notice with

respect to noise from premises at the site location was served by the former Derry City Council under Article 38 of the Pollution Control and Local Government Order 1978.

The Environmental Health Service holds no further information on any other environmental complaints related to the site.
