Environmental Information Regulations 2004 Request Prehen Boathouse

Thank you for your correspondence regarding Prehen Boathouse and the Council plans for the development of the site.

Further to this I can advise that Derry City and Strabane District Council (DCSDC) through the Health and Community Committee has given consideration to the future development of Prehen Boathouse. The report presented on 19th July 2018 sought approval for the development of a feasibility study/business case and following a procurement exercise, this work is now ongoing.

Grant aid of £120,000 has been secured through Sport NI towards the development of a pontoon at the Boathouse, with further match funding agreed by DCSDC on 3rd July 2018. This equates an overall development fund of £600,000 for the completion of the pontoon and supporting changing and access works. The appointment of the design team is currently ongoing following a previously unsuccessful process. I enclose an example of the public advert for Design Services for New Pontoon at Prehen Boathouse.

The Prehen site is also included within the wider city investment proposition, with consideration being given to the potential for a wider private sector led development brief for the site following consideration by the Governance and Strategic Planning Committee on 6th November 2018.

The Council is supporting the development of a Foyle Forum, a network of user/interest groups to assist with design/development input and deliver future programming. The development of outdoor recreation in its widest context across

the District Council area will also form an integral part of the new Sport and Physical Activity Strategy currently in the initial phases of development.
