

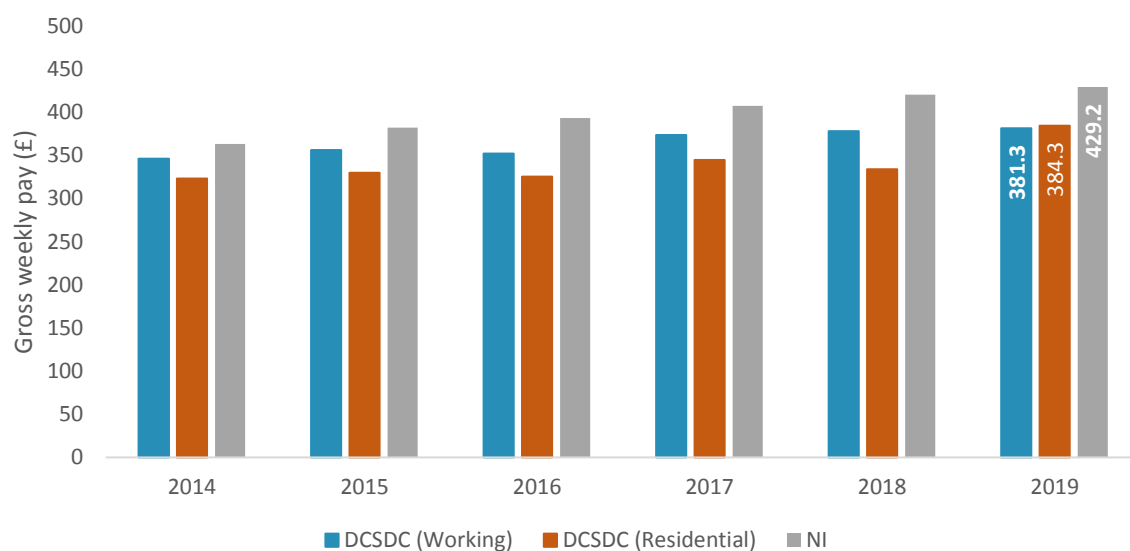

- In 2019, the gross weekly median pay for those working in DCSDC was £381.3 compared with a figure of £384.3 for those who live in the council area. Both of these were lower than the overall NI average (£429.2).
- Until 2019, those working in DCSDC tended to earn more than those who live in DCSDC. This is as a result of a greater tendency of workers to commute into the council area for higher earning employment. Data for 2019 suggests an increase in male earnings, specifically for those who reside in the council area. It remains to be seen if this trend continues or is a result of sampling variability within the source data.

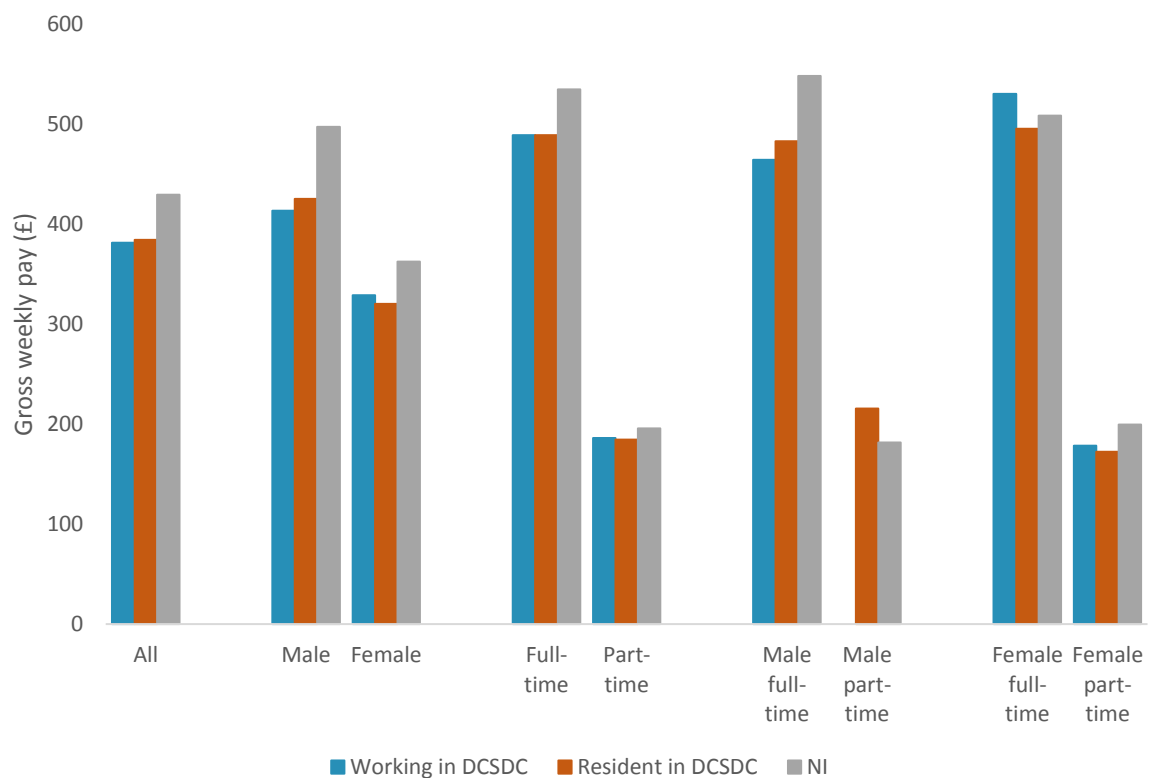
