Environmental Information Regulations 2004 Request Smoking in Vehicles Fines

I refer to your EIR request as above and respond as follows:

While the Northern Ireland Assembly voted in favour of introducing a ban on smoking in vehicles when children are present in February 2016, no such legislation has been enacted in Northern Ireland. The response to your request therefore is:

- How many people have been fined because of smoking in a vehicle carrying • anyone under the age of 18?
