For each LDP stage / document, the key wording of the respective Regulation is set out and highlighted in bold, i.e. the legal requirement for public notice and availability of the documents.

The subsequent pages include a sample of the advert as it appeared in 'one newspaper' for 'two successive weeks'. (This complies with the Regulations, but the adverts from the range of newspapers are included here.)

For the LDP draft Plan Strategy (dPS) stages (not for the Timetable, SCI or POP), the Regulations also require an advert to be placed in the Belfast Gazette (BG); in these cases, the BG advert is also included in this document.

The wording of each advert demonstrates that it includes all the content, the availability of documents (at principal offices and on the Council's website) and the timescales – all as required by the Regulations.

The legislative requirements for advertisement of the Timetable Revision and the SCI Revision are both as per the earlier versions, see above. However, the requirements for advertising the dPS Proposed Changes is guided by the following DPPN 10:

The Planning (Local Development Plan) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015 PART 5 Development Plan Practice Note 10: Submitting Development Plan Documents for Independent Examination (DPPD 10 - Dfl – December 2019)

The Council is required to prepare the LDP, taking account of all Departmental Guidance, including DPPN 10 - which provides the key guidance to Councils on how a DPD progresses from the representation stage to submission to the Department. In particular, paragraphs 4.1 to 4.11 advise on how the Council can respond to the Representations it has received, as well as to any significant changed circumstances. This DPPN introduces a 'non-statutory administrative stage' in the LDP-preparation process, whereby the Council can identify 'Minor changes' and 'Focussed Changes' that it believes should be brought forward, as an Addendum to the LDP dPS - all of which can be considered by the PAC at the Independent Examination.

The DPPN guides the Council, saying that in order for the focussed changes to be considered at the IE, satisfactory consultation should take place; therefore, a Council should prepare, publish and **consult upon the focussed changes.** The addendum of focussed changes, together with an SA and other statutory assessments (as required), should be published for consultation for a period of 8 weeks which corresponds to the timeframe specified in Regulation 16.

Derry City & Strabane District Council, in taking account of this Departmental Guidance, has published a Schedule of Proposed Changes, all of which has been advertised and consulted upon in accordance with the above guidance, similar to that done for the original dPS itself - under Regulation 16 / PART 5 of the Planning (LDP) Regulations (NI) 2015.

Though this is a non-statutory administrative stage, arising from DPPN 10, the requirement to make available, advertise and consult – was considered to be similar to that specified for the earlier DPD stages; therefore, it was all undertaken in the normal manner i.e. local advertisement and the Belfast Gazette.


