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What are RAPID bins?

RAPID bins are a health and community safety initiative supported by local agencies to promote and facilitate the removal of all types of prescription and illegal drugs from the local community.



What does RAPID mean?

Can I use a RAPID bin?

The bins provide a safe way for anyone to dispose of drugs. If you have, or come across, unwanted or unused drugs, you can deposit them in the RAPID bin safely and discreetly, ensuring they are out of circulation for good.



I want to remain anonymous?

The RAPID drug disposal bin is purposefully located to offer as much anonymity as possible to those making the deposit. Police and your local Connections Service routinely collect and record information on drugs deposited in the bins however no personal information is required or sought.



What can be disposed of in RAPID bins?

- ✓ Any illegal drug or 'legal highs'.
- ✓ Any unwanted or unused prescription or illegal drugs.
- ✗ No wastepaper or general rubbish.
- ✗ No sharps, knives or needles of any kind.
- ✗ No suncreams, moisturiser or make-up.
