Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request Fines for Dog Fouling

I refer to your FOI request as above and respond as follows:

Q5: Under current legislation it is an offence to allow a dog to foul in public places. Council have poop scoop and disposable bag receptacles in popular walkways/parks throughout the Council district, however it is not currently a requirement of a dog licence to carry such. Guidelines and good practice would suggest that this be done.
